Home Learning Policy

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At Alver Valley Home learning is the opportunity to develop the home/school partnership and to strengthen children's learning through the support of parental participation. Research from the Education Endownment Fund (EEF) recognises the positive impact parental support has on children's progress and ensures they are successful.

Our Aims

This home learning policy aims to:

- > Explain the expectations for the home learning per year group.
- List activities which consolidate learning in school, strengthening fluency and understanding.
- > Provide experiences for parents and children to collaborate at home.
- > Develop children to become confident life-long learners.

Teachers will give guidance on the amount of time needed to be spent on home learning activities. These activities will range from talking homework, fluency in maths (arithmetic and times tables), reading, spelling, punctuation and grammar practice (SPAG). In addition to, a family learning project, which will fire imagination and drive motivation in a subject specific area.

The homework will be issued on a weekly basis and children are expected to finish the work given in the time set. All children are expected to read or share books for a specified amount of time (See table below). A reading journal will be provided for parents/carers to check and sign once a week.

Feedback will be given to the children, by the class team through discussions and they will be encouraged to reflect on progress made or any misconceptions they may have.
